### TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Canton Flannels are 4 harness weaves with a 3 up - 1 down configuration. This construction gives the material its noticeable twill appearance (i.e. the cloth appears to have lines moving up the cloth on a left-hand diagonal. It is a warp faced twill (i.e., it has more warp threads than filling threads) made with heavy, coarse, soft filling yarn and fine, lighter weight warp yarn. The cloth is napped on the back - the soft-twisted filling giving a long, thick, heavy "fleecy" nap. Canton Flannel is particularly suited to use in work gloves as the twill facing on the material gives it a strong surface to resist wear, while the nap on the back makes it more comfortable to wear. Canton Flannel is flexible, pliable, relatively cheap, provides good wear.

If a more technical comparison is desired, the type of weave, the construction, the yarn size, and the thread counts per square inch can also be compared. However, the end user should primarily be concerned with the characteristics of the material rather than how they are achieved. This is particularly true since different means can be used to achieve approximately the same end.
